

# **Regional Trails Council (RTC)**

### **Program Coordinator, Staff**

Supports programs in partnership with volunteer leaders, land managers, and partner organizations.



## Local Trails Committee (LTC) Chair

Accountable for planning and reporting on the maintenance and development of the trails or lean-tos in a defined geographic area. Supports Trail Supervisors, Corridor Managers, and Crew Leaders.



## Trail Supervisor

Oversees team of Maintainers to ensure their area's trails are maintained in good condition.



### Trail Maintainer

Cares for assigned 1- to 2-mile trail section.

## Shelter Caretaker

Cares for assigned leanto. Reports to Supervisor or Chair.

## Corridor

# Manager

Oversees team of Monitors and ensures the Appalachian Trail boundary is protected.



## Corridor Monitor

Protects and monitors the Appalachian Trail boundary.

## Crew Leader

Oversees team of crew members to build and restore trails. Reports to LTC Chair where work takes place.



#### Crew Member

Recurring or episodic volunteers that participate in crew projects.

# Sawyer

USFS certified to remove large blowdowns. Part of Chainsaw Committee.



### **Swamper**

Anyone assisting a sawyer.

# Regional Trails Council (RTC) Chair

Creates and fosters a sense of community for the region by organizing and running meetings/gatherin gs throughout the year that help the region's volunteers gain insight and expertise on best practices and local operational issues.
